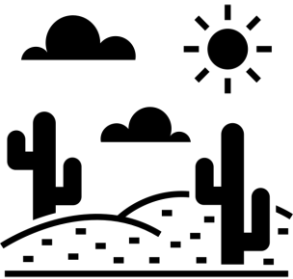

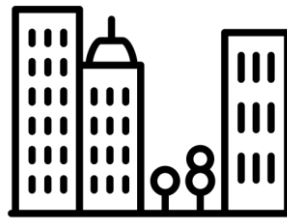


Countryside

Word	Definition	Symbols
habitat	The natural home or environment of an animal or plant.	
micro - habitat	A small-scale, specific habitat which supports the survival of certain animals or plants. <i>E.g. a rotting log.</i>	
adaptation	The process by which a living thing becomes fitted to its environment.	
environment	The surroundings or conditions in which a person, animal, or plant lives or operates.	
survival	Staying alive.	
basic needs	The things a plant or animal must have to stay alive.
