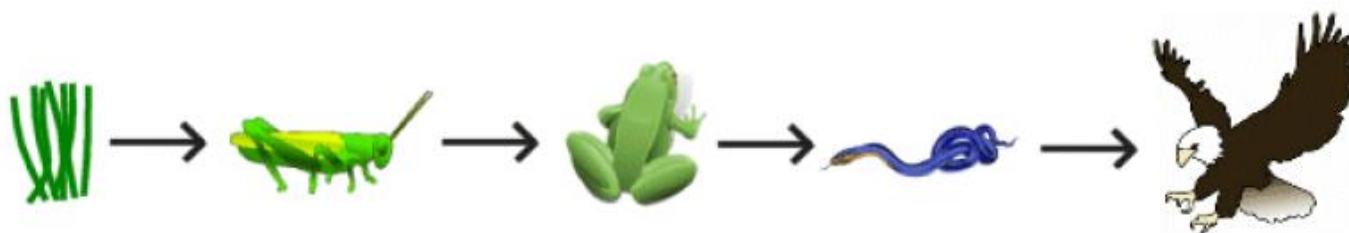


## Science
