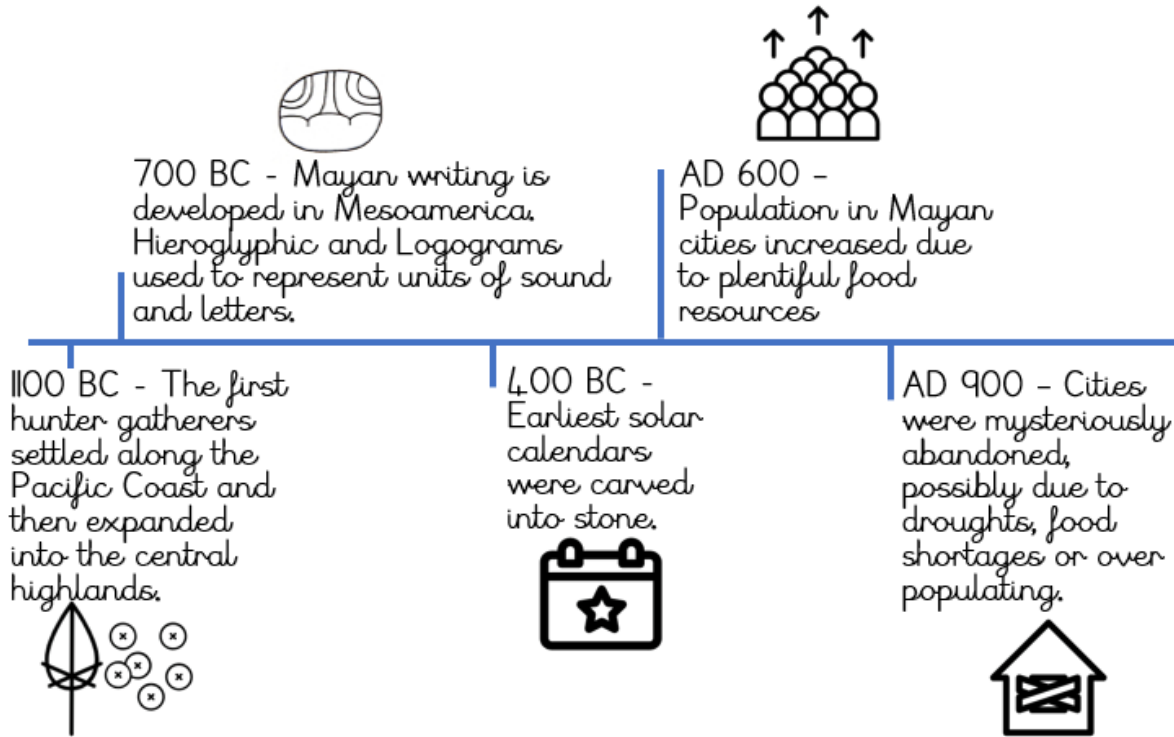




History

Timeline of some key events of the Mayans.

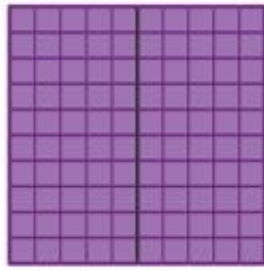


Vocabulary

Word	Definition	Icon
Civilisation	An organised society with its own culture and way of life, existing in a particular period of time.	
Ritual	A ceremony, often religious, with set actions performed in a set order.	
Hieroglyph	A written system that uses symbols instead of letters and words.	
Equivalent	Two values or quantities which are the same	

Maths Fractions

To compare and order fractions, you must have the same denominators.



$$\frac{1}{2} = \frac{5}{10} = \frac{50}{100}$$

Arrows indicate the operations: $\times 5$ and $\times 10$ for the first step, and $\times 5$ and $\times 10$ for the second step.

To find equivalent fractions, we multiply or divide the numerator and denominator by the same number.

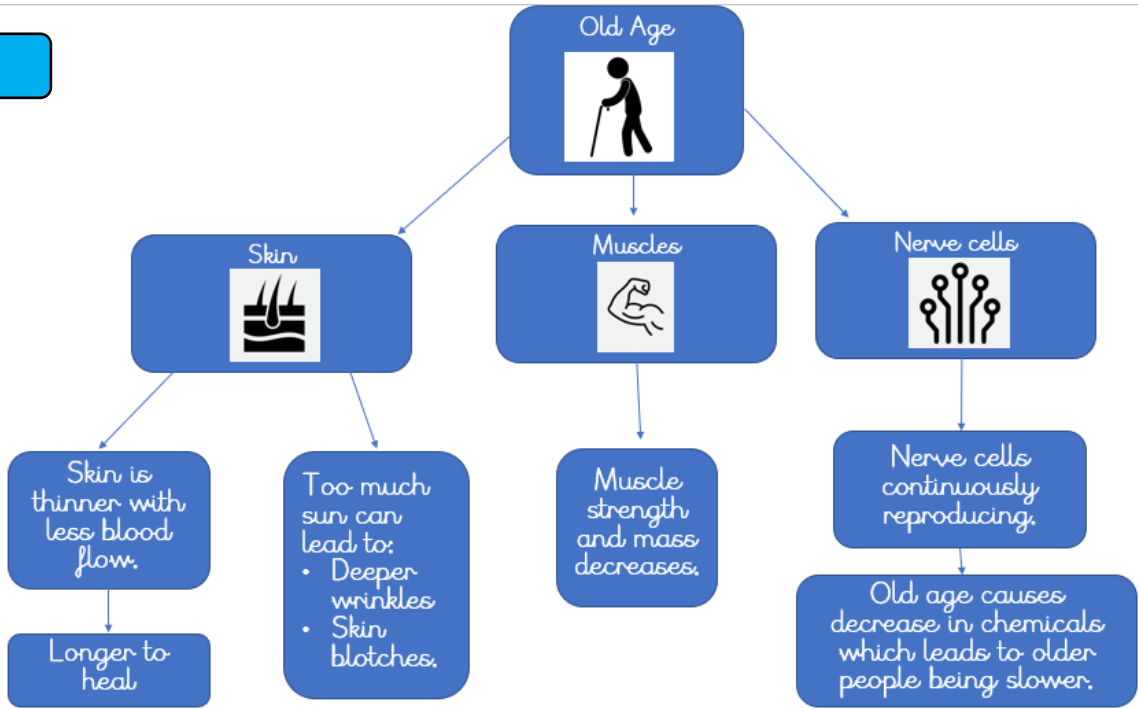
Examples of finding common denominators:

- $\frac{1}{3}, \frac{5}{6}, \frac{7}{12}$ → $\frac{4}{12}, \frac{10}{12}, \frac{7}{12}$
- $\frac{1}{3}, \frac{7}{12}, \frac{5}{6}$ → $\frac{4}{12}, \frac{7}{12}, \frac{10}{12}$

Example of comparing fractions:

$\frac{11}{8} > \frac{5}{4} = \frac{10}{8}$
