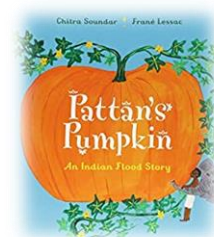
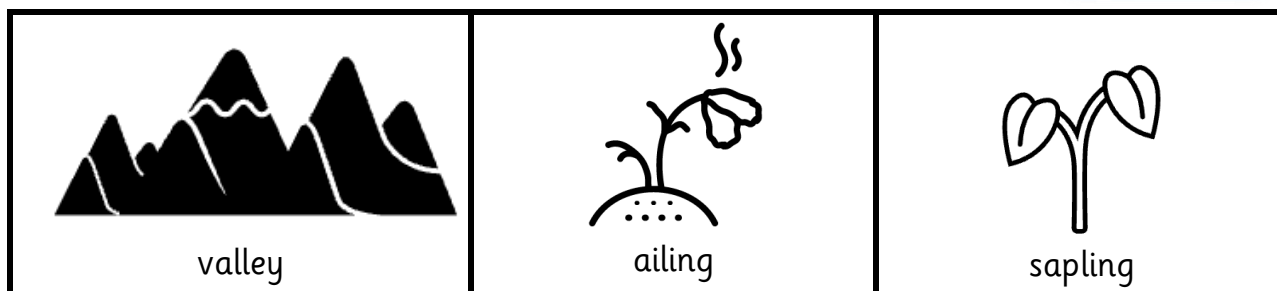


W/C 1st November 2021, we will be sharing the story:
