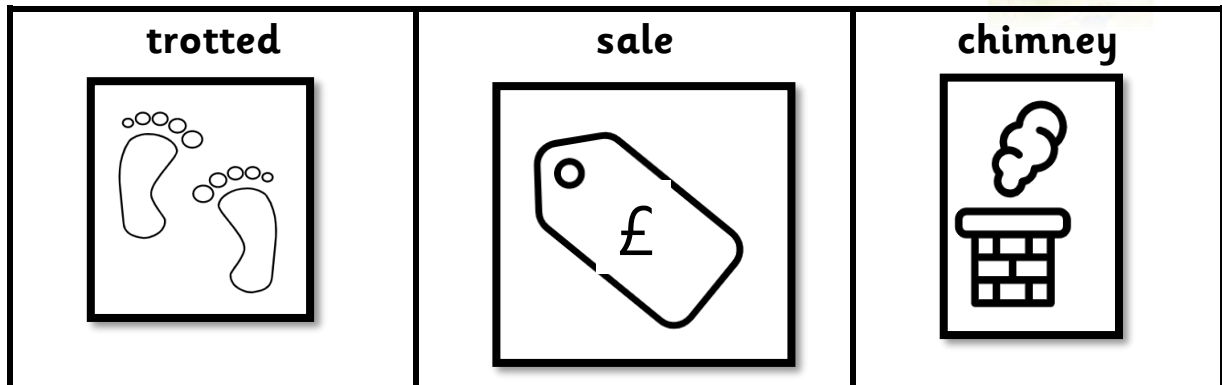


W/C 3rd January, we will be sharing the story:
