




Adult Butterfly – lays  
eggs.

Chrysalis – goes  
through complete  
metamorphosis to  
emerge as a butterfly.

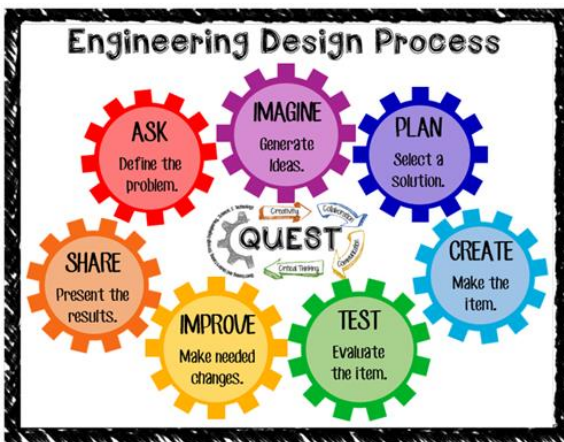


Eggs – hatch into  
larvae or caterpillars.

Caterpillar – Feeds on  
leaves, hangs upside  
down to form pupa.

Word	Definition	Symbols
life cycle	A series of stages a living thing goes through during its life.	
food chain	Food chains show the transfer of energy from one living thing to another.	
producer	They make up the first level of a food chain. Producers create their own food/energy.	
consumer	An animal that eats a plant or other animal.	
prey	An animal that is hunted and eaten by other animals.	
predator	An animal that hunts and eats other animals.	

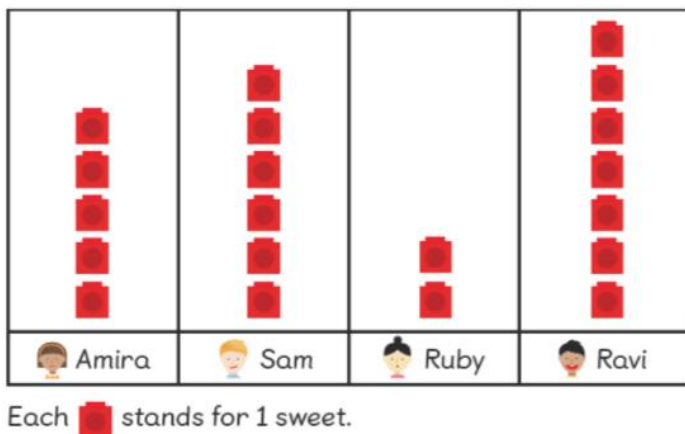

tools	A device used or worked by hand or a machine to perform a task.
material	What an object is made from.
fold	To bend something over on itself so that one part of it covers another.
