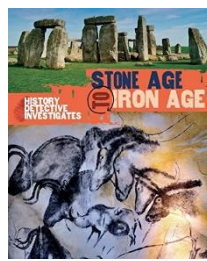

Stone was replaced by metal.

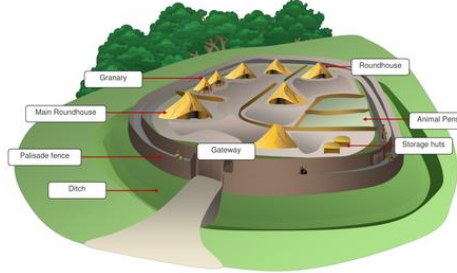
Bronze Age

**Fossilisation:** A fossil is the preserved remains or traces of a dead organism. The process by which a fossil is formed is called fossilisation.

	H	T	O
	3	13	7
+	1	2	9
	4	6	6

- 1) Add the ones.  $7 + 9 = 16$
- 2) Exchange 16 ones.  
*1 ten and 6 one*
- 3) Add your tens.
- 4) Add your hundreds.

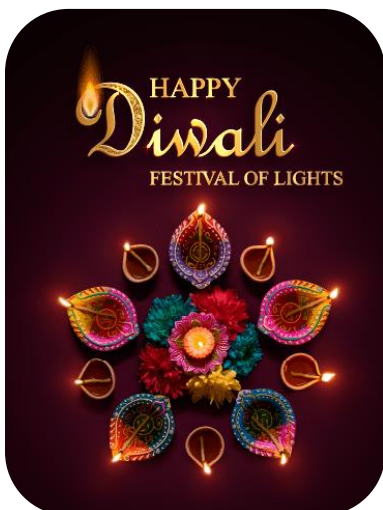
### Column subtraction

H	T	O
3	23	17
1	2	9
2	0	8

- 1) Subtract the ones.  $7 - 9$   
- Rename 1 ten (10 ones)  
- You now have 17 ones.  
-  $17 - 9 = 8$
- 2) Subtract the tens.
- 3) Subtract the hundreds.
