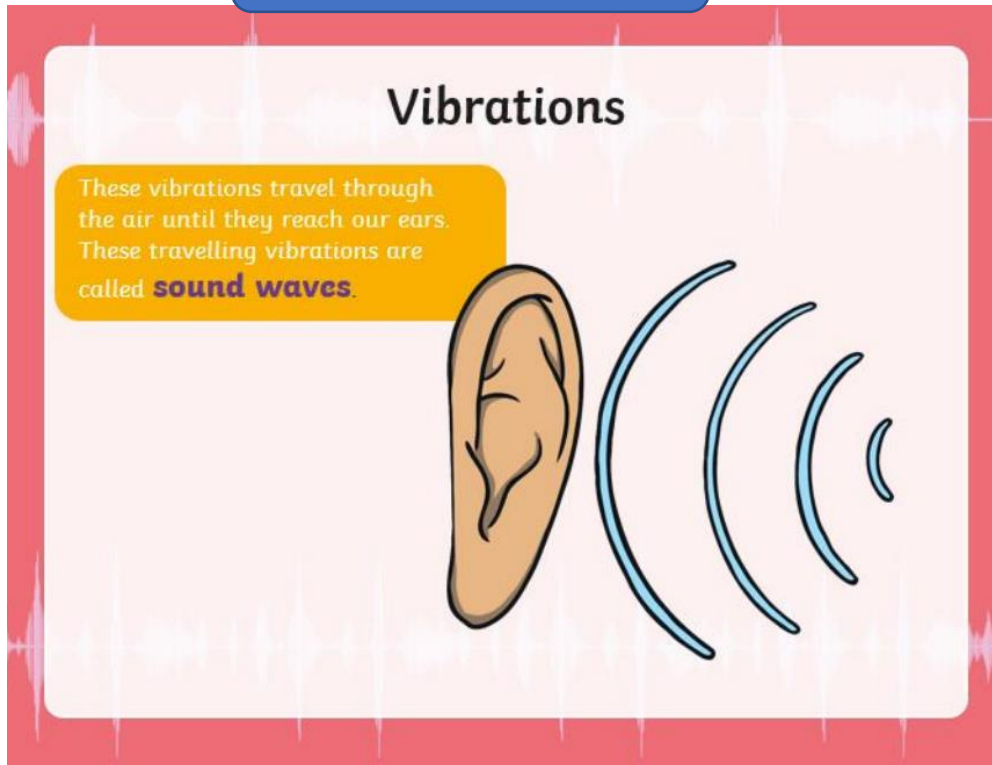

Vibration	Sounds are vibrations that travel through the air.	
Pitch	The pitch of a sound is how high or low the sound is.	
Volume	The volume of a sound is how loud or quiet the sound is.	
Sound waves	Sound travels as waves, which are vibrating particles.	
Medium	The material that sound travels through (solids, liquids and gases)

Design	A plan or drawing produced to show the look and function or workings of a building, garment, or other object before it is made.	Components	A part or element of a larger whole, especially a part of a machine or vehicle.
Tools	A device or implement, especially one held in the hand, used to carry out a particular function.	Construction	The action of building something, typically a large structure.
Materials	The matter from which a thing is or can be made.	Evaluate	The making of a judgement about the amount, number, or value of something; assessment.
