Year 1 – Seaside Adventures

In Year 1 during the Summer term, we will be exploring the United Kingdom and the surrounding seas and learning all about birds and fish. We would like to end this topic with a trip to the seaside to compare where we live to a seaside town.

We are planning to go to Cleethorpes on Wednesday 15th June for a day at the seaside. During the day, we will enjoy our lunch in a park near the beach, walk down the coastline to see the attractions and have some time to play and eat ice cream on the beach.

The children will need to come to school at the usual time in order to leave promptly at 9:00am, wearing comfy clothes suitable for the day. We do request that your child wears their school jumper however children do not need to bring a bag as lunch will be provided for them. We will provide the children with Fairfield high visibility vests to wear over the top of their coats.

We aim to return to school for 4:00pm. To ensure we can safely dismiss children, we will be leading them off the bus and into the school hall for collection (car park side).

In order for our day to go ahead, we are asking for voluntary contributions to cover the cost of the day. The total cost of the visit is £17.00 per child. If your child is entitled to pupil premium, the voluntary contribution will be reduced by 50%. This charge will soon show on your child's School Money account. All payments are to be made through the School Money payment system at www.schoolmoney.co.uk

We know that the children will love the trip to the seaside and we are very much looking forward to seeing the outcomes of the day!
