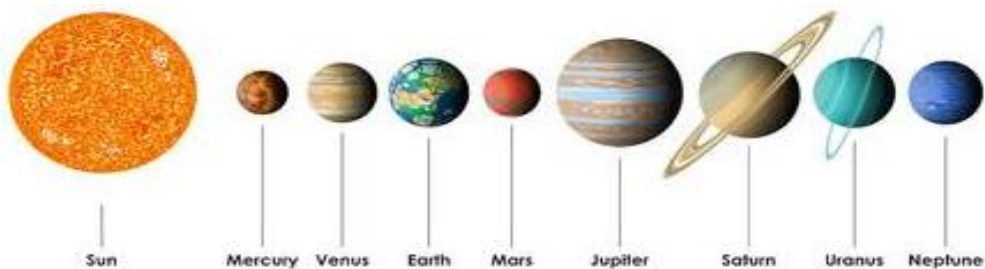
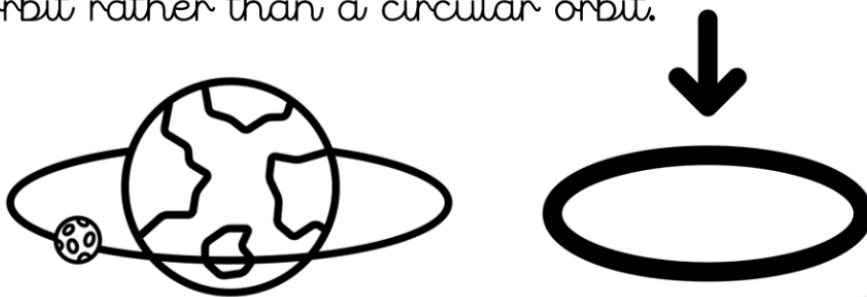

The solar system



A 'moon' is the name of a body which orbits another body, as long as it is not a star.

The Moon takes 27 days (and 8 hours) to orbit the Earth. The Moon has an elliptical orbit rather than a circular orbit.

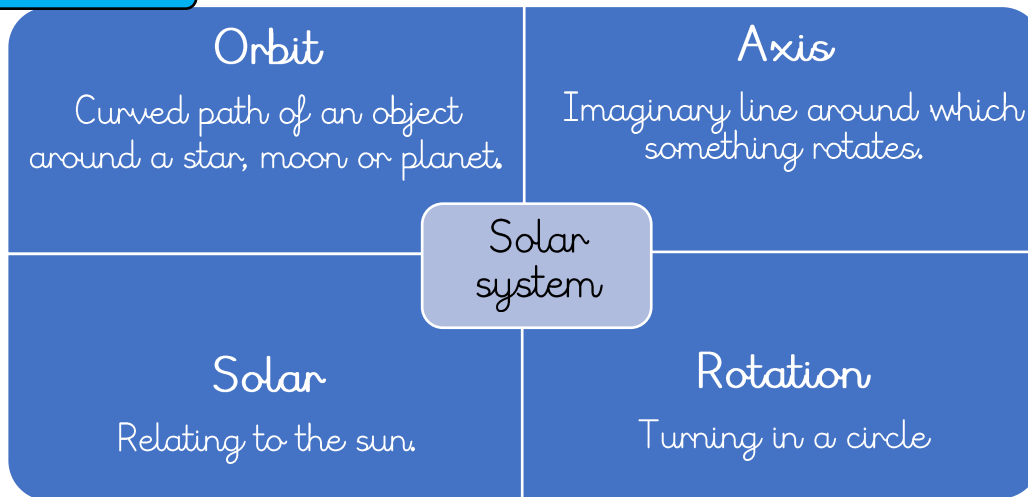
Edmonia Lewis

- An American sculptor, of mixed African American and Native American (Ojibwe) heritage. Born free in Upstate New York, she worked for most of her career in Rome, Italy.
- She was the first African-American sculptor to achieve national and then international prominence
